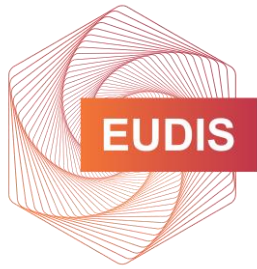

- **Announcement & start of onboarding of selected companies:** overview of the full programme, matchmaking with coaches, presentation of accelerator leads, etc.



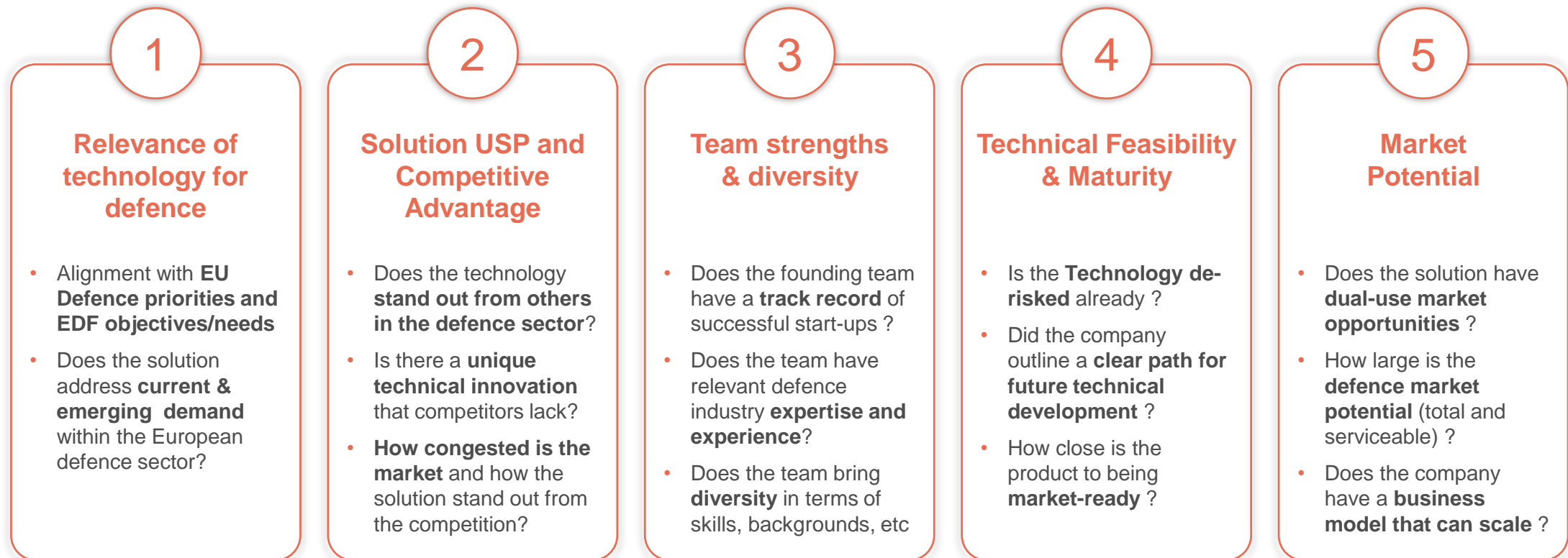

1. Additionally, evaluators will carefully assess the financial stability of applicants, including secured funding, ongoing commercial contracts, and other relevant indicators of financial robustness



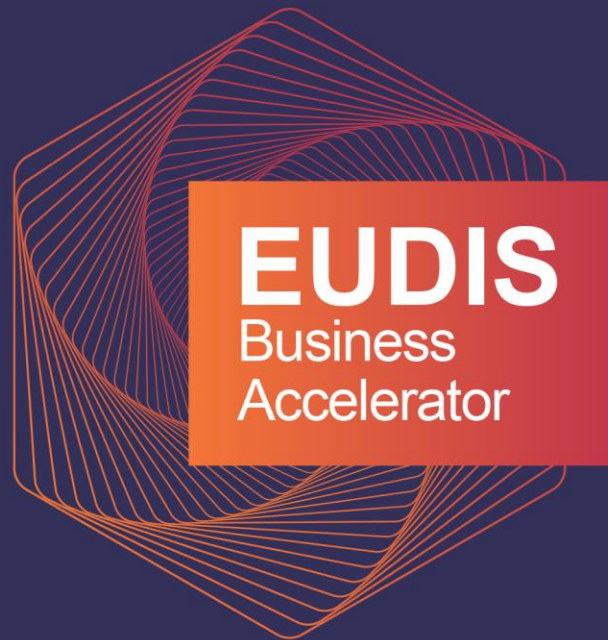
